Phonics

Systematically builds from no reading to complete letter recognition and letter-sound knowledge.

- ▶ Spell child's name
- ▶ Recognize A through Z
- ▶ Recognize a through z
- ▶ Learn all letter sounds

Comprehension & Vocabulary

Develops vocabulary and critical thinking skills through rich reading experiences.

- ▶ Read along and understand 26 nursery rhymes
- ▶ Read along and understand 26 alliterative books
- ▶ Learn 255 target vocabulary words

Language Concepts

Introduces concepts of print conventions and reading readiness.

- ▶ Understand print (left-to-right, letters, pictures, words, text)
- ▶ Develop reading readiness skills

Phonological Awareness

Develops awareness of individual sounds in words.

- ▶ Match words that rhyme
- ▶ Identify the number of syllables in words
- ▶ Blend onset/rime
- ▶ Identify initial sounds
